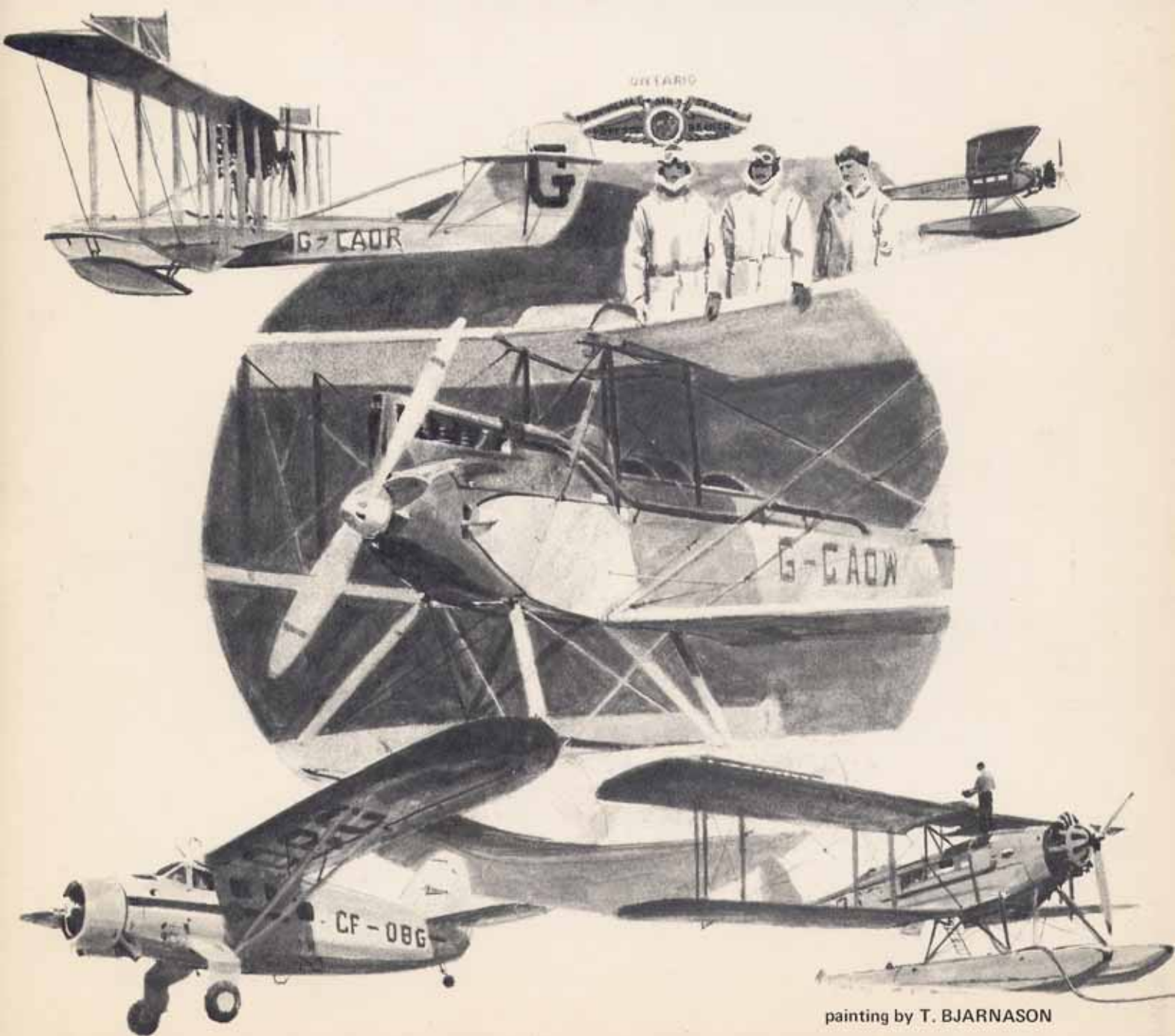

SHIELD INSIGNIA CARRIED ON EACH SIDE OF BOW OF HS2LS  
LETTERS WHITE, BACKGROUND COLOR UNKNOWN, AIRCRAFT  
WERE IDENTIFIED BY NUMBER. USED IN THE LATE '20'S

BELOW: WINGED CREST WAS USED FROM 1945 TO 1966 ON FWD.  
SIDE OF FUSELAGE. COLORS: BLACK & WHITE WITH RED WINGS,  
LINED WITH WHITE



WINGED CREST WAS CARRIED ON EACH SIDE OF FORWARD HULL ON HS2LS & ACROSS  
THE NOSE ON (DENINGS) (FACING FORWARD) DURING THE 20'S. IT WAS ALSO PRINTED ON THE  
BRICK SURFACE OVER THE HANGER DOORS AT THE SAUITE STE. MARIE BASE WHERE IT MAY  
BE VIEWED TO THIS DAY FROM INSIDE THE NEWER ADDITION. COLORS WERE: OVERALL  
YELLOW WITH BLACK LINES & LETTERS



MONOGRAM O.P.A.S. INSIGNIA WAS INSERTED IN A BREAK IN THE  
SPEED LINE ON FORWARD FUSELAGE AS PART OF THE BLACK TRIM  
ON OVERALL YELLOW SCHEME USED FROM LATE 1930'S TO ABOUT  
1945. IT WAS HAND PAINTED AND VARIED IN SIZE.

BELOW: CURRENT STICKER-TYPE ALSO DISPLAYED NAME OF DEPT.  
OF LANDS & FOREST PRIOR TO CHANGE. SOME VARIATIONS OCCUR  
IN STYLING OF COAT OF ARMS:



COLORS: WINGS & OUTLINE NAT.  
METAL, CIRCLE BACKGROUND RED,  
RIBBON WHITE, "ONTARIO" WHITE.

ONTARIO COAT OF ARMS COLORS: SHIELD GREEN,  
CROSS RED ON WHITE, LEAVES BROWN, ANIMALS  
BROWN & BLACK.
