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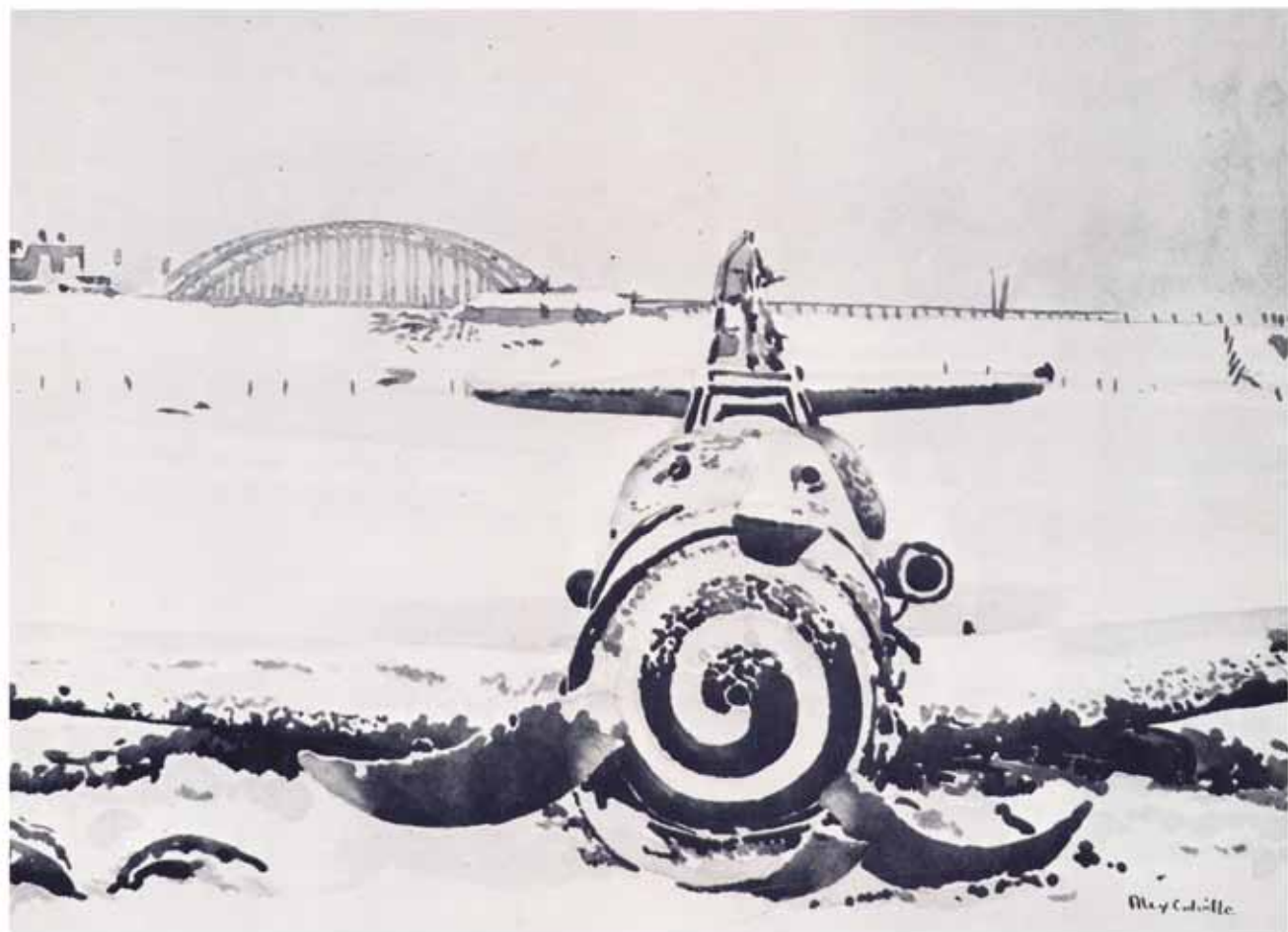
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DOWNED MESSERSCHMITT. Rather different from the present style of internationally renowned Canadian artist, Alex Colville, these two watercolours of the same crash-landed aircraft were painted in Holland when he was an official war artist attached to the Canadian Army. The lower one, *The Raider* (AN 12203) was done on 4 January 1945, while the upper one, *Me 109 in Snow, Holland* (AN 12183) is dated 11 January.
